




As technology seeps into every aspect of life, Filipino dating habits undergo transformation. Tinder emerges as the most popular dating app among Filipino users.

Online dating apps provide opportunities to expand social circles, with Filipinos having a realistic view on the possibility of turning these newfound connections into long-term romantic relationships.















Contrary to the perception that online relationships lack depth, Filipinos find meaningful connections through digital platforms.

Filipinos also tend to check the photos first when searching for matches. This pattern underscores the significance of visual appeal and the role it plays in the initial stages of online dating.

















While women prioritize safety, men's concerns in dating apps revolve around a different aspect: the lack of physical touch and intimacy.






Filipinos pay considerable attention to interests and hobbies. This suggests that they value finding common ground and shared passions as a foundation for building relationships.





